As with Once-a-Week Unit Studies, Once-a-Week Micro-Studies engage the whole family. This provides you the freedom to consolidate their studies by teaching all your children the same topic at the same time.

Once-a-Week Micro-Studies are different in that they are a digital product. While we do offer a Grab-N-Go, digital alternative of our physical Once-a-Week Unit Studies, Once-a-Week Micro-Studies come only in a digital format. Because of this, we are able to incorporate quality educational links to enhance your children's learning experience.

Once-a-Week Micro-Studies are suggested for grades 1-8, whereas Once-a-Week Unit Studies are suggested for grades 2-12.

Once-a-Week Micro-Studies are different in that they do not include weekly library lists.

Due to their condensed nature, Once-a-Week Micro-Studies do not include regular family devotionals. While these do make an occasional appearance they are not incorporated into every week's assignments.

Also due to their condensed nature, Once-a-Week Micro-Studies do not satisfy scout requirements as do Once-a-Week Unit Studies.
